### Request:

1. How many of these applications have been granted IHR or IOD back dated to their date of retirement?

#### Answer:

The SMP considered 22 applications pursuant to the *PSNI* and *PSNI* Reserve (Injury Benefit) Regulations 2006 as one application was withdrawn in advance of an SMP assessment. Five applications were backdated to the date of retirement.

#### Answer:
